How can i set a user-password

Selecting the pdf-file with a mouse-click. Activate the button "Change". Insert the password in the below, right part of the program window in the field "user password" and a second one in the field "main password". There's a faster option, too. If you don't set the main password the user password will be the main password, too. Before clicking on "Save" you have to select an encryption mode. You can't set any security options without an encryption mode! 40-bit-encryption is enough and you should take it. Okay... 128 bit are safer but then the users need at least the acrobat reader version 5.0 - Users with older versions could not use the pdf.

How to set a main password

Selecting the pdf-file with a mouse-click. Activate the button "Change". Insert the password in the below, right part of the program window in the field "main password". Before clicking on "Save" you have to select an encryption mode. You can't set any security options without an encryption mode! 40-bit-encryption is enough and you should take it. Okay... 128 bit are safer but then the users need at least the acrobat reader version 5.0 - Users with older versions could not use the pdf.

How to remove a main password

Selecting the pdf-file with a mouse-click. Insert the password in the below, right part of the program window in the field "main password". Now click on the button "Unlock" - Ready!

You've lost your main password and the resources of your pdf-file? No problem anymore! You only have to select the pdf-file with a mouse-click. Now clicking on the button "Reset main password" - Ready!

Why i see a "No" in some settings obviously i've selected a "Yes"?

Perhaps you've selected 40-bit-encryption. With this older encryption mode you can't set few security options. For example the permission to fill formfields is such an option.

Can i remove unknown passwords

User passwords are very save and i don't know a tool for removing user passwords from pdf files. However the PDF-Analyzer Pro is able to reset the main password and the complete security settings with one mouse click. Now there's no need to be frightened because of the forgetting of passwords and the losing of resource files anymore!

What does this mean "Copying allowed - Yes/No"

Naturally you can copy a pdf file from one directory to the other for example - it doesn't matter if this option is set or not. "Copying allowed - No" means that it's not possible to select content of a displayed pdf file (perhaps an image or a text part) and to copy it into the clipboard.
